



Campton & Chicksands Diamond Jubilee Celebrations Saturday 2nd June and Sunday 3rd June

- ☺ The Women's Institute will be there selling refreshments to keep you going.
- ☺ At 4.30pm the winners of the various competitions – Bike Time Trial, Decorated Cup Cake, Fancy Dress, Floral Arrangement, Photography and Victoria Sponge, will be award their prizes, receiving them from Sir Stanley Odell and the Mayor of Shefford Councillor Paul Mackin.
- ☺ **At the Manor** there will be Skittles, Croquet and homemade lemonade.
- ☺ **At All Saints' Church** the Osborne Crypt will be open to the public. There will be a display of floral arrangements and an exhibition of local arts and crafts together with historical maps and photos of the village.
- ☺ At 3pm there will be a quarter peal by Campton bellringers local band followed by 'Have a go at Bellringing', your opportunity to ring the bells at Campton for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.
- ☺ At 8pm the evening's entertainment in the Marquee will be provided by local band "The Rock Factor" playing hits from the 60s, 70s & 80s together with a Disco [sorry this is now sold out]. If you have been lucky enough to get a ticket please remember to bring your own drinks and plastic containers to drink them in and a torch to light your way out of the recreation ground at 11.30pm.

Then on **Sunday at 11am** there will be a special celebratory service to commemorate H M Queen Elizabeth II's Diamond Jubilee in church followed in the afternoon at **3pm** with a Campton's Got Talent Show and sing-a-long.
